

How to for parents

Each week this term we'll be looking at a part of Isaiah 40-66. Following the outline below will help you get the most of out the material provided.

1. Look through the material, in particular the discussion questions, before doing it with your children. This will help you know the order for the material for that particular day.
 - a. For example there may be a game suggestion before the talk/questions to help children start to think about the themes of the material or it could be a game afterwards to solidify the things they just learnt
2. Follow the suggestions on the discussion questions.
3. Look at the video with your children.
4. Do the craft.
5. Do the memory verse and song if there are any for that week.
6. Pray together

This is a guide and it may not be the best fit for every family. There are plenty of ways that you can be talking to your children about God and teaching them from the book of Isaiah. The material for Kids Church this term follows along with the sermon series for the adults so the children are learning about the same themes and ideas as the parents. Why not discuss over dinner what you've each been learning or find a different way to help your children process the new thing they have learnt instead of playing a game or doing a craft. We want this material to be able to help you teach your children in a way that suits you.

We pray that this term we will all be excited to learn each week from the book of Isaiah.
